Call for Presentations



ISODC is proud to publish this official call for presentations and workshops at our 2022 International Conference. We encourage seasoned OD practitioners and academics, as well as OD students to submit their papers for consideration! Presentations are a great way to share your research, your practice experiences, and your innovative ideas in OD and Change. Presenting at the conference can benefit you by gaining constructive feedback on your work, strengthening expertise, finding collaborators for continuing projects, and building your CV. Presentation categories and specifics for submissions for those categories are listed below.

Submission deadline: To be considered for a conference presentation at this year's ISODC international conference, your presentation proposal must be submitted no later than 1159PM US EDT on **March 04, 2022.**

There will be three types of presentation formats offered at the 2022 ISODC Hybrid Conference. These include Professional Presentations, Student Research Presentations, and Professional Workshops. Descriptions of each category are provided below. Presentations can be made inperson or in our virtual conference platform.

This year's conference has three exciting conference tracks that align with the conference theme. Alignment of presentations and workshops with the conference theme and tracks are encouraged. However, presentations and workshops are not limited to those tracks, particularly student presentations. All timely submissions are welcome and will be reviewed and considered for presentation.

<u>Professional Paper/Presentation Submissions</u>

These presentations include talks on organization development practice, intervention research, academic research, practice innovation, and theory. They are limited to 20 minutes in length, with 5 minutes of post-presentation questions, for a total of 25 minutes. This presentation category is designed to share the latest work in the field, including completed academic research, intervention research, unique and novel practice methods or techniques, innovative ideas, novel organizational research methods, and new OD-related theory.

Professional Presentation Submission Requirements:

- 1. Cover page with *Full Name*, *Name of Affiliation*, and why you want to make a presentation at the ISODC Conference. Also, please make sure the cover page identifies whether you will be presenting in-person or virtually.
- 2. 1-page double spaced description of presentation (abstract), no more than 250 words. Include the presentation title. Title is not included in the 250 word maximum limit.
- 3. Send submissions by email to: **isodcBenedictineConference2022@gmail.com** before midnight Eastern USA time on **March 04, 2022.**



4. Presentation submitted after this date may or may not be reviewed because of slot limitations.

Submission deadline: March 04, 2022.

Student Research Presentation Submissions

Student presentations can be based on ongoing student research, including student dissertation research concept presentations. Students are encouraged to submit their proposals regardless of alignment with the conference tracks. Student presentations are limited to 15 minutes in length, with 5 minutes of post-presentation questions, for a total of 20 minutes. These presentations are designed to share student research concepts and proposals. This is a fantastic opportunity to receive constructive feedback regarding topics, research design, research methods, and other aspects of research, and to glean some insight from highly-experienced and regarded researchers and practitioners in the field of OD.

Student presentations are invited for students currently enrolled in any OD or OD-related program performing OD-relevant research. Professional Presentations are Invited and encouraged by anyone.

Student Presentation Submission Requirements:

- 1. Cover page with *Full Name*, *Name of Affiliation* (University). Please make sure the cover page identifies whether you will be presenting in-person or virtually.
- 2. 1-page double spaced description of presentation (abstract), no more than 250 words. Include the research title. Title is not included in the 250 word maximum limit.
- 3. Send submissions by email to: **isodcBenedictineConference2022@gmail.com** before midnight Eastern Daylight Time (EDT USA) on **March 04, 2022.**
- 4. Presentations submitted after this date may or may not be reviewed because of schedule and slot limitations.

All Professional Presentations and Student Presentations at the ISODC Conference will:

- 1. Have a total of 25 minutes NO More!
- 2. 15 minutes for the Student Presentations YOU WILL BE STOPPED when 15 minutes are DONE. 10 minutes for questions to student presenters.
- 3. 20 minutes for Professional Paper Presentations. 5 minutes for questions to professional presenters.
- 4. 5 minutes to transfer to the next speaker
- 5. NO EXCEPTIONS MADE Further discussion can be made informally at lunch, or outside the presentation rooms.

Professional Workshop Submissions

Professional Workshop Submission Requirements:

- 1. Cover page with *Full Name*, *Name of Affiliation*, title of your workshop, length of proposed workshop (60 minutes or 90 minutes), and why you want to teach a workshop at the ISODC Conference. Also, please make sure the cover page identifies whether you will be presenting in-person or virtually.
- 2. 1-page double spaced summary of the workshop you are proposing to teach to our esteemed audience, and why this workshop is beneficial to ODC practitioners and scholar-practitioners.
- 3. Send submissions by email to: **isodcBenedictineConference2022@gmail.com** before midnight Eastern USA time on **March 04, 2022.**
- 4. Presentation submitted after this date may or may not be reviewed schedule because of slot limitations.

All Presentations:

Submitters will be notified of acceptance status by March 18, 2022.
